



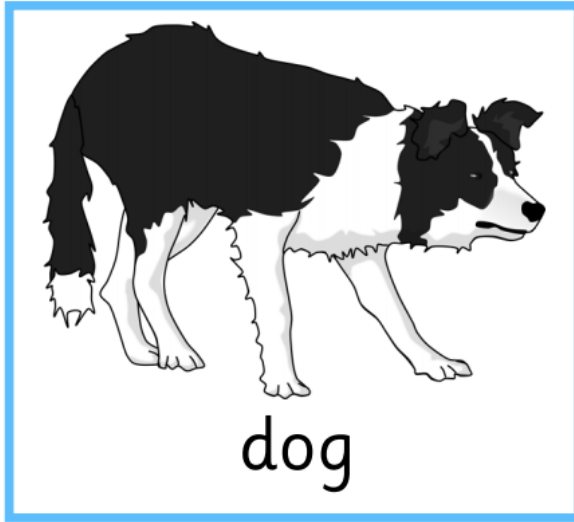

Objective	Identify desirable qualities in friends and understand that a friendship is a two way process	Recognise that all living things change as they get older and become more independent and relate to humans. Understand the importance of personal hygiene and take responsibility for this	Understand humans produce babies which grow into adults	Recognise their feelings about people change and that there are a range of relationships they will be able to encounter and is able to say no when feelings become uncomfortable.
Key question	What makes a good friend?	Why is it important to keep clean?	Where do babies come from?	How can I tell people how I feel?
Problem	<p>Give each child a piece of a paper jigsaw/ outline of hand. Ask the children to write something they would want their friend to be. Place ideas down and discuss.</p> <p>Someone says a friendship needs give and take, what do they mean? In small groups write 5 bullet points about how this works</p>	<p>We have just looked at the different stages that animals go through. Can you in your groups draw 4 stages that humans go through.</p> <p>Make a list of things that you should do to keep yourself clean at any stage of life.</p> <p>With post its can you label when you have to do a different thing to clean ie. babies change nappies</p>	<p>Have 2 pieces of paper one which says external (outside their mother) other says internal (inside their mother)</p> <p>Place your animal on piece of paper where you think the baby came from? Quick check of answers.</p> <p>Look at human. Show some pictures of a baby/ babies growing inside of a human (scans).</p>	<p>List all the different relationships that the children know, going around a circle.</p> <p>A friend of yours has started to tell you they really like you, you don't feel the same. What could you be thinking? How would this make you feel? What could you do about it?</p>
